What is Perfect Pitch



- A communications workshop series & pitch night occuring over three months (January, February and March 2024.)
- Workshops focus on
 - o telling your story what is your why?
 - storytelling strategy & building your pitch
 - own the crowd presentation & slide design
- 7 local not for profits will deliver a 5 minute pitch to a sold out crowd in March 2024
- ticket prices and a portion of sponsorship grants will go directly to participating charities
- 400+ business leaders, community builders and donors coming together to support the community

- Waterloo Region based charities and organizations with a charitable sponsor.
- The application is a short, 5 question form covering
 - leadership & governance structure
 - organization focus & mission
 - role in the community
 - what story are you hoping to tell
 - o example of previous coaching or capacity building experience


Be a part of a program that
